Ensure that every student succeeds with:

1. **Effective Learning** through:

- Ensuring that Explicit Instruction Project Team supports staff to fully embed EI practices (AIP strategy 1.1, meeting 2018 AIP targets of 87% A to C in Science, Maths and English)
- Implementing effective formative, summative and moderated assessment practices based on the Australian Curriculum and SATE syllabuses (AIP strategies 1.2, 1.3 & 1.4)

2. **Exceptional Staff** through:

- Developing and maintaining a highly skilled and capable workforce, with a focus on the skills and knowledge to embed the Australian Curriculum in the Junior School and emerging QCAA senior syllabuses (AIP strategy 2.1)
- Engagement with professional learning teams, cooperative and collaborative teaching based on action research (AIP strategy 2.2)
- Engagement with BASE school cluster (Bracken Ridge SHS, Aviation High, Sandgate DSHS, Earnshaw College) in shared professional development, moderation and assessment practices (AIP strategy 3.3)

3. **Strong Partnerships** through:

- Enhancing traditional and digital media communication strategies to support and positive partnerships with parents, caregivers and key community partnerships leading to school growth (AIP strategies 3.1, 3.2 and 3.3, AIP target of 555 enrolments by 2019, sustain 2018 School Opinion Survey satisfaction rates at or equal to 95%)
- Reviewing and developing quality relationships with key vocational and tertiary education stakeholders to provide innovative learning opportunities and diverse pathways for students (sustain key partnerships, including MRAEL, TAFE, Deception Bay, EPIC and more)
- Sustaining key VET partnerships to ensure all non-OP student gain a nationally recognized Certificate by exit (meet or exceed 2018 AIP targets of 100% Certificate II and meet or exceed 89% for Certificate III).

4. **Well-Being** through:

- Focusing on *Every day counts* and *Back to Basics* - with students in attendance, alert, equipped and ready to learn (AIP strategy 4.1 and 4.2)
- Providing coordinated and targeted student support services within a clear Wellbeing Plan and team operations(2018 AIP strategy 4.1 & 4.2)

Our initiatives include

- Sustaining project groups of expert teacher teams and teacher aides to support teachers implementing and embedding whole school literacy and numeracy programs
- Continued employment of our Community Liaison Officer to build and sustain community and school partnerships, promote effective communication across the whole school community
- Employment of an Attendance Officer (A02 at 25 hours/week to implement innovative, positive and effective attendance strategies to build an attendance culture (meet 2018 AIP attendance target of 95 % or above)
- Sustain innovative strategies ensuring that we track and support every Year 12 to exit with a QCE (meet 2018 AIP target of 100%)
- Building leadership skills in the Leadership Team through identifying and sharing best practices within faculties to ensure improved student outcomes

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Community Liaison Officer supporting strategies (\$75 105)
- New Attendance Officer position to supporting *Every Day Counts* attendance (\$26 140)
- Additional Teacher Aide time to support student with learning difficulties (\$50 401)
- Indigenous Teacher Aide to support *Closing the Gap Strategies* (\$8592)
